

**Mandatory Language for Monitoring / Reporting Violation Chemical Sampling
CHEMICAL MONITORING, ROUTINE MAJOR**

The City of Beeville water system PWS ID 0130001 has violated the monitoring / reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to collect and submit chemical samples of water provided to their customers and report the results of those samples to the TCEQ on a regular basis.

We failed to monitor and / or report the following constituents chlorite.

This / These violation(s) occurred in the monitoring period(s) August 2017.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from chemical contamination. We did not complete all monitoring / reporting for chemical constituents, and therefore TCEQ cannot be sure of the safety of your drinking water during that time.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

The City of Beeville has contracted Inframark Company to oversee the distribution sampling. This will eliminate any miscommunications between the Water Plant and the City of Beeville distribution personnel.

Please share this information with all people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
